




Figure 2-Egypt in the Future, a book by Prof. Dr. Ali El Fayoumi.




Figure 3-Science and Technology in Society, translated and adapted by the British Project SATIS, which was published by the ASE (Society of Science Teaching), by a group which Dr. Ali El Fayoumi was a president of.




Figure 5-Project of the Academy of the Arab Child, by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi.




Figure 6-Project of the Child City, by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi.




Figure 8- Creativity and Education, research done by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, the Vice President of Menoufiya University for Higher Studies and Research, in a conference held by the Egyptian Ministry of Education, under the guidance of the Minister of Education. N.B: This book includes the subject of Integrated Science, one of the methods of education of creativity.




Figure 9-Creativity and Development of Scientific Concepts for Children, by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, the Professor in Faculty of Education in Ain Shams University, Advisor of the Minister of Education, and Dean of the College of Specific Education in Ashmun, Menoufiya. N.B: This book includes the subject of Integrated Science, one of the methods of education of creativity.




Figure 10-The Modernisation of the Sixth Republic of Egypt, Part 1, published in March 2014. By Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, professor at Ain Shams University, and former Vice President of Menoufiya University.




Figure 12-Modernisation of the Egyptian State, published in June 2014, by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, Professor at Ain Shams University and former Vice President of Menoufiya University.




Figure 13-Project of the Academy of Childhood, Motherhood, and Youth: A book by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, Vice President of Menoufiya University for Environmental and Societal Development, published in 1997. Recommended by the Conference of Children's Health, Culture, and Environment.




Figure 14-The Child and Creativity, a book by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, published by the Family Library, in accordance with the Egyptian Book Authorization.




Figure 15-The Arab Child and Creativity, a book by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi.




Figure 16-A Student's Guide to Chemistry, for Thanaweya Amma Egyptian High School Diploma. Dr. Ali El Fayoumi was the President of the Committee of Exam Models.




Figure 17-Egypt in the 21st Century, a book by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, published in 2006 by the Family Library, in accordance with the Egyptian Book Authorization, as part of the Science and Technology Series.




Figure 18-Encyclopedia of Qena Icons in the Twentieth Century, Part 1. A book by Bahbah Fekry, where he lists a number of influential figures born in Qena in the nineteenth century, including the likes of Dr, Ali El Fayoumi, along with the Minister of Education Fathi Sorour, and General Omar Soliman. Dr. Ali's photograph can be seen on the cover of this encyclopedia.




Figure 20-Environment: The National Project of Egypt in the 21st Century. A book by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, the former Vice President of Menoufiya University. This book was published in October 2001.




Figure 21-Water: The Miracle. A book by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, former Vice President of Menoufiya University.




Figure 23-The Annual Environmental Magazine for Menoufiya University, under the supervision of Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, including the writings of many professors on the environment according to their specialties. This is the third issue, published on the 27th to the 28th of June 1998.




Figure 24-The Necessity of Developing Faculties of Education, a book by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi, the Vice President of Environmental and Societal Development in Menoufiya University, published in 2000.





Figure 25-Polymers and Petrochemicals, a book by Dr. Ali El Fayoumi.




